Re: Submission of Nominations for IACS Awards and Proposals for Hosting the 15th ICC

IACS will present two awards at the 14th ICC in Seoul – the ICC Award and the Heinz Heinemann Award. I request that you distribute the attached announcement of these award and call for nominations through your national catalysis society. Please note that the deadline for nominations is **January 15, 2008**. All nominations should be submitted to me by email to the following address: bell@cchem.berkeley.edu. The recipients of these awards will be selected by the IACS Awards Committee, and it is planned to inform the recipients by **March 15, 2008**. Both recipients will be invited to present a plenary presentation at the ICC in Seoul.

I am also requesting that national catalysis societies interested in hosting the 15th ICC submit a proposal to me by **April 30, 2008**. This proposal should contain details concerning the following items:

- Venue for the 15th ICC
- Outline of the technical program
- Availability of accommodations and expected costs
- Proposed budget and expected source of support – governmental and industrial
- Program for accompanying persons
- Transportation to and from Congress city and site
- Proposed pre- and post-Congress symposia

If your national society decides to submit a proposal to host the 15th ICC, it may wish to look at the proposal submitted by Korea for the 14th ICC as a model of what is expected. A copy of the Korean proposal may be found on the IACS web site (www.iacs-icc.org).
